EPA has reviewed the available information and has to come to the conclusion the following items will be necessary to reach a Record of Decision on the Hadnot Point Industrial Area Operable Unit.

A workplan addendum to:

further investigate the soil contamination present at the facility

complete the deep aquifer characterization


complete the environmental assessment for the Hadnot Point Industrial Area

the steps to be taken to complete the risk assessment for the entire Hadnot Point Industrial Area

Ultimately, the goal is to fully characterize the shallow soils, the shallow aquifer, and the deep aquifer; and to assess the human health and environmental risks posed by the site as a whole. The Record of Decision for the Hadnot Point Industrial Area would include the soils, and the deep aquifer and would also include the final decision on the shallow aquifer. In light of this objective, I believe your suggestion to include the additional work listed above with the work plans for the areas not yet addressed (Sites 21, 22, 24, and 28) in the Hadnot Point Industrial Area is appropriate.
