I am pleased to submit on behalf of Baker Environmental, Inc. (Baker) one bound copy and one unbound copy of the Monitoring Report for Operable Unit (OU) No. 1, Marine Corps Base (MCB), Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. The report describes activities completed as part of the monitoring program at Sites 24 and 78 during the third quarter of 1997. The report also presents the results of ongoing groundwater extraction and treatment operations. Two copies of the monitoring report have been forwarded to Mr. Neal Paul at MCB, Camp Lejeune. Additional copies of the report have been distributed according to the attached transmittal letters.

Based upon the observations and findings presented within this monitoring report, the installation of four new recovery wells is recommended. Two additional recovery wells have been proposed for both the northern and southern treatment systems. It is recommended that the recovery wells be placed within the most contaminated portions of each plume. The final locations of the recovery wells will be dependent upon laboratory analyses from groundwater samples collected from temporary wells installed and sampled during February of 1998. Details regarding the proposed recommendations will be presented at the March Partnering Meeting at MCB, Camp Lejeune.
