## SUBJ: CLOSURE OF CONTAMINATED WATER WELLS

1. Fifteen water wells are currently out of service due to contamination. These wells have various levels of contamination, and some of the wells may be recoverable. Guidance is needed on what to do with the wells. A new well costs approximately \$120,000 and replacement cost for the secured wells is over \$1,800,000. If the wells can not be reclaimed, removal of equipment, demolition of well houses, and capping of wells need to be pursued.

2. The wells currently secured are as follows:

602 ESE 660 (formerly 601) ESE 608 ESE RR-227 TT-23 EPA Region IV 645 TT-26 AS-106 AS-4150

3. These wells have been closed since 1984, and no recommendations have been received regarding how to proceed, even though guidance has been requested in 1988 and 1989. Request guidance on closure of the wells to allow action for recovery or replacement of the wells.
