Dear Ms. Del Re':

As you are aware, preparations for the RI/FS at the ABC One Hour Cleaners Superfund Site are ongoing. The information you provide will be very helpful in the remediation of this site.

The USGS Water-Resources Investigations Report 89-4096 which you gave to me during our meeting at Camp Lejeune on March 28, 1990 indicates that a number of production wells are located in Tarawa Terrace. Please answer the following questions concerning these wells:

- 1. When were wells TT-26, TT-25 and TT-23 in operation and when were they not in operation?
- 2. Since contamination was not detected in well TT-25, why was it taken out of service?
- Are the other wells in this area, such as X-24, T-9, TT-31, 3. TT-52, TT-53, TT-54 and TT-69 still in operation? If not, then why and when were they taken out of service?
- Has the abandoning of wells TT-26, TT-25 and TT-23 caused a 4. hardship to Camp Lejeune? (Rationing of water during dry spells, etc.)
- 5. During our meeting on March 28 it was brought to my attention that Camp Lejeune had sampled the wells in Tarawa Terrace. Please send me a copy of the analytical data on the wells you have sampled in this area.

Please send me this information on or before April 25, 1990. Your prompt attention to this matter is greatly appreciated. If you have any questions contact me at 404/347-7791.
