Dear Mr. Butler:

Field work for five Site Investigations at the Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, is scheduled to occur approximately June 10 through July 2, 1991. Sites 3, 7, 54, 80, and 82 will be investigated as identified in the referenced Work Plan, and the upcoming revised Work Plan. Site Investigations for the remaining four sites will be conducted under a separate field effort.

Decontamination of heavy equipment will occur sporadically and in brief periods during this three week interval. We intend to remove any potential gross contamination on-site and to conduct final decontamination on vehicle washracks, one located at the Marine Corps Air Station and the other at the Hadnot Point Industrial Area. These washracks are equipped with oil-water separators. Effluent from these is discharged to the sewer system.

As discussed between you and Ms. Laurie Boucher of our office on April 26, 1991, you will notify us by May 17, 1991, if the State of North Carolina does not concur with approach.
