Enclosed please find the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) proposed schedule for upcoming Interagency Agreement (IAG) negotiations among the Department of the Navy (DON), the North Carolina Department of Human Resources (NCDHR), and EPA representatives. The EPA is encouraged by the DON's willingness for early response to Marine Corps Base (MCB) Camp LeJeune potentially being finalized for the National Priorities List. EPA has determined that IAG discussions for Marine Corps Air Station New River shall be developed separately due to the fact that this facility is not contiguous with MCB Camp LeJeune. However, this does not preclude the possibility that RI/FS activity for both facilities could be conducted concurrently. The EPA is confident that a clearly defined IAG for MCB Camp LeJeune will provide a mechanism open to public review that will adequately address their environmental concerns at the facility.
