Comments concerning the Draft Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study Health and Safety Plan Operable Unit No. 13

- 1. Page 3-6, section 3.5.2: According to Camp Lejeune's Fish and Wildlife Division, the coral snake also exists in southeastern North Carolina. This venomous snake should be mentioned in addition to the pit vipers.
- 2. Page 4-1, section 4.3: Ensure that a "safety zone" boundary, surrounding a given drilling operation is established and delineated with flagging tape or cones.
