The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has completed its review of the above subject document. Upon review of the document, it was noted that there are several pesticide detections in sediments above the screening level (scr). Although, the levels are above scr, they appear to be in line with levels typically found at Military Installations. It is the Agency's recommendation to proceed with the no further action decision, however the narrative should be strengthened by adding text that addresses the frequency, pattern and magnitude of the detections. The Agency also suggests verifying this information with the State.
