We reviewed of these documents and submit the following comments:

- 1. The groundwater exceeds the North Carolina groundwater standards; a plan for the groundwater remediation needs to be developed. Depending on site-specific conditions, monitored natural attenuation with institutional controls may be appropriate.
- 2. The clean up goals in the Remedial Work Plan should be changed to match the clean up goals in the Action Memorandum and the EE/CA.
- 3. Attached are Dave Lilley's comments on the BRA in the EE/CA and the Final Pre-Remedial Investigation Screening Study.
