In our letter of 3 September 1992 we requested that the parties to the MCB Camp Lejeune, Federal Facilities Agreement extend the period for review and comment of the referenced document for an additional 30 days.

After discussing this with Michelle Glenn, EPA Region IV, it was decided not to request an extension that would extend into the new fiscal year. We therefore are requesting an extension for a sufficient amount of time (probably a few days), to resolve discussions that are now taking place concerning the preferred alternative for the referenced project.
