Dear Ms. Berry:

The NC Superfund Section has reviewed the referenced document and plans. Our comments, which were prepared by both the Superfund Section and NC DEM, have been adequately addressed, and although we request consideration be given to the following comments, this letter shall serve as our concurrence with the document.

- 1. A sampling tap has not been provided at the outlet of the treatment system. If this is not necessary, please indicate where the effluent sample will be obtained on Drawing C-5.
- 2. Ball valves appear to be omitted in the process schematic at each Liquid Phase Carbon Units on Drawing C-5.

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3. We requested that a detail be provided that would indicate the backwash discharge be directed through the floor grate in order to eliminate splashing.

The NC Superfund Section recommends that consideration be given to those comments noted above, and revisions be made to the construction Drawings.

Additionally, our comment letter of May 17, 1993 discussed start up procedures and carbon unit operation requirements. The start up procedures have been included in the PRAP. Where will the "Carbon Unit Operation" procedures be discussed? Will there be an Operation Manual? Please advise.
