Subj: INSTALLATION RESTORATION SITE #41

1. Operable Unit #4, which is composed of Installation Restoration Sites #69 and #74, is a collection of sites which possibly contain chemical surety agents. This grouping was initiated in 1992 due to the Rifle Range Chemical Dump (Site #69) and the Mess Hall Grease Disposal Area (Site #74) potentially containing buried chemical surety materials.

- 2. According to the March 1983 Initial Assessment Study of Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, certain wastes deposited at Site #41 were "described as being similar to those disposed of at the Rifle Range Chemical Landfill" (Site #69). Although the classification of the respective material is uncertain, the possibility of buried chemical surety agents at Site #41 exits. As a result, it is requested that this site be included in Operable Unit #4. This will not only expedite investigation and remediation, but it will also insure our future compliance with the Chemical Weapons Compliance Treaty of 1995.
