Dear Mr. Shiver:

In accordance with Title 15A, Chapter 2, Subchapter 2N of the North Carolina Administrative Code, enclosures (1) through (4) are submitted for closure under the Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) Program.

Upon underground storage tank removal, analytical results from samples taken in the excavation at each of the four sites (BB-46, BB-9, BB-51, TC-942, and STC-868) revealed petroleum contamination. Therefore, investigations including soil borings and the subsequent installation of monotoring wells were performed. Under these investigations, soil and groundwater samples analyzed revealed petroleum contamination levels that were below regulatory limits.
