Air Quality

The selected remedy will not require an air permit and will not need to be registered with the Air Quality Section.

Pages vi, vii, viii, 1,4,7,8,9,10,11 of the report have been copied and will be retained on file by the Air Quality Section. This information will be public information. If this is unacceptable, CLMCB, or Baker Environmental must contact NC DEHNR.

Water Quality

It is not clear how Camp Lejeune will dispose of the treated groundwater.

Groundwater Section

We recommend that the five year review, as stated on page 49 of the ROD, be mandatory, as the groundwater treatment system addresses source areas only.
