COMMENTS TO THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT UNIT FACILITY ASSESSMENT STUDY

- 1. (General): It is requested that the consultant provide an executive summary that includes a concise synopsis of the report and a compilation of proposed action at each site. Please have the consultant provide Camp Lejeune a draft copy of the executive summary for review prior to finalization.
- 2. Pg. 1-1, Section 1.2, Para. 1, Line 14, should read: "EnSafe inspected the <u>units</u> from..."
- 3. Pg. 1-2, Line 4, should read: "...of being previously unidentified SWMUs or"
- Pg. 2-3, Line 1: Please identify acronym "PBJ".

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- 5. Pg. 2-4, Line 7, should read: "...chemical agent resistive coating (CARC)...." Also, there are additional categories of waste paint, such as epoxy paint and oil-based paint.
- 6. Pg. 3-2, Line 19, should read: "There are 8 steam generating plants at Camp Lejeune. The main generating plant, Building 1700, is permitted to burn both coal and No.6 or No. 2 fuel oil. ...the power plant is a major contributor of SOx, NOx, and particulate emissions."
- 7. Pg. 4-1, Line 18: "Pollutants may also reach the air through volatilization and as combustion products."
- 8. Pg. 5-4, Line 14: Please list the additional FFA sites in column format.
- 9. Pg. 5-5, Line 7: Delete "These are too many to be described in this report."
- 10. Pg. 5-5, Para. 5.2, Line 3, should read: "...is currently evaluating all USTs on-site."
- 11. Table 5-2: Change "SV" to "VR" to represent visual evidence of release.
- 12. Table 5-2: Clarify page numbering designations.
- 13. Appendix D: Clarify page numbering designations.
- 14. Please provide a brief summary of projected costs involved in the various activities contained in the project recommendations.
