1. page 8-3 - Telephone number for Security - 911 or 2555; Fire (Courthouse Bay) - 911; Fire (Hot Work Permit) - 7221, Contact - Area Fire Captain; Public Works (Underground Utilities via EMD Contact) - 5068, and off-base - (910) 451-5068.

- 1. spine Change from Operable Unit No. 4 to read Operable Unit No. 9.
- 2. page 3-9, para 3 What methods (instrumentation), other than visual observation, will be utilized to determine if soil/groundwater is contaminated and can be disposed of "on-site"?
- 3. Figure 5-1 This figure incorrectly shows the bollards installed within the concrete pad surrounding the well casing. The text indicates installation of the bollards in concrete noncontiguous with the pad.

### COMMENTS ON DRAFT FINAL REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION/FEASIBILITY STUDY WORK PLAN FOR OPERABLE UNIT 9 (SITES 65 AND 73)

- 1. page 2-2, para 5 General Note: The use of "Amphibious" in unit titles is no longer appropriate. The Marine Corps has changed the unit titles to "Expeditionary". Therefore, in all unit titles replace the word "Amphibious" with the word "Expeditionary."
- 2. page 2-3, para 3 Replace verbiage in sentence to reflect that Marine Corps Base (MCB), Camp Lejeune now functions as host command to Marine Forces Atlantic (MARFORLANT) tenant activities -- Headquarters of the II Marine Expeditionary Force, 2d Marine Division, and the 2d Force Service Support Group (FSSG).
- 3. page 6-1 It is requested that Baker Environmental, Incorporated provide MCB, Camp Lejeune a detailed daily calendar of scheduled field work to include Baker Environmental, Incorporated personnel on-site and the activities to be conducted.
