The NC Superfund Section has completed its review of the Interim Record of Decision for Operable Unit 10 and concurs with the selected remedy subject to the following conditions.

- The State recognizes that the selected remedy (In Well 1. Aeration and Off-Gas Carbon Adsorption) represents only portion of the investigation and remediation one activities that are to be performed at Site 35. Α Treatability Study is to be conducted to determine the viability of this technology for the site. If the results of the Treatability Study are not acceptable, the contingency remediation method is Groundwater Collection (interceptor trench) and On-Site treatment.
- This concurrence is based on the information presented in 2. the Record of Decision, Remedial Investigation Report, Feasibility Study and the Proposed Remedial Action Plan. Should the State receive new or additional information which significantly affects this concurrence, it may be modified or withdrawn with appropriate written notice to the Navy and EPA Region IV.
