COMMENTS CONCERNING TIME CRITICAL REMOVAL ACTION PLAN FOR OPERABLE UNIT NO. 11

SITE 80

- 1. Page 1-2, Section 1.2 <u>Site Description</u> and Page 2-1, Section 2.0 <u>Remedial Action</u> <u>Objectives</u>. The base cover approximately 170 square miles. *Should read 234 square miles*.
- 2. Appendix A, Site Specific Health and Safety Plan, Appendix C. Some MSDSs are difficult to read, this should be at least corrected so that the on-site Health and Safety Plan has legible MSDSs.
- 3. Appendix A, page 8-10, Section 8.6.1 <u>Notification Procedures</u>. This information will help the on-site emergency coordinator to assess the magnitude and potential seriousness of the spill or release. *An additional statement should follow:*
 - "Once the spill or release is discovered, 911 the Base Fire Safety Division (Emergency Response Team) needs to be immediately notified, as well as the Installation Restoration Division".
