Dear Ms. Landman:

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has completed its review of the above subject documents. There is a minor concern with the proposed no action alternative. There are areas of groundwater which exceed the MCL and NCWQS limits. Although, there is only hit slightly above the <u>primary groundwater</u> standards, North Carolina does not make a distinction between primary and secondary. If the State agrees to a no action plan of action then EPA will support the decision. However, if this is not the case then it will be EPA's recommendation to provide a semiannual monitoring plan (to show consistency in data) and impose water use restrictions.
