Dear Ms Townsend:

Based on your review comments dated August 11, 1997, the following actions have been taken:

- (1) The Remedial Action Work Plan was revised to reflect a PCB removal level of 10 ppm for surface and subsurface soils.
- (2) Based on discussions at our partnering session on 19 November, 1997, land use restrictions will be placed on the highway construction contractor. These land use restrictions will ensure that the soils excavated from Site 36 as a result of highway construction will remain on site.
- (3) The area south of the dirt road on Site 36 was sampled as part of the Work Plan, and one 10^{\prime} x 10^{\prime} area of PCB contaminated was removed to a depth of 18 inches.

The Time Critical Removal Action was completed during the month of October 1997, and the Close Out Report is currently being finalized. Please direct any questions or comments to Kate Landman at (757)322-4818.
