Dear Mr. Hocutt:

As discussed in your telephone conversation with Mr. Mick Senus on June 12, 1997, enclosure (1) is submitted for approval to transport and dispose of debris generated at Marine Corps Base (MCB) Camp Lejeune, Lot 203, to the base sanitary landfill. The debris consists of wood, plastic hoses, black rubber rafts, concrete, rubber, track pads, and scrap metal. A copy of a site map for Lot 203 is included as enclosure (2).

Also discussed was the transport and disposal of eight truck loads of yellow rubber rafts. These rafts are not included in the enclosure and will be handled separately because of minimal cadmium contamination as identified in enclosure (3). Our plans are to transport and dispose of these rafts at a commercial lined landfill located in Sampson County.
