Dear Ms. Landman:

I am pleased to submit on behalf of Baker Environmental, Inc. (Baker) two unbound copies of the Quarterly Monitoring Report for Operable Unit (OU) No. 2, Marine Corps Base (MCB) Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. The report describes activities completed as part of the monitoring program at Sites 6 and 82 during the fourth calendar quarter of 1997. Two copies of the quarterly report have also been forwarded to Mr. Neal Paul at MCB, Camp Lejeune. Additional copies of the report have been distributed according to the attached transmittal letters.

In order to provide a more detailed and accurate assessment of treatment system efficiency in the future, it is recommended that each shallow and deep recovery well be sampled periodically. Discrete groundwater samples could be obtained from each recovery well via an existing relief valve. It is recommended that groundwater samples be obtained at least once quarterly and submitted for volatile organic analyses only. Contaminant concentrations in groundwater samples from each recovery well could then be determined, providing a measure of recovery well efficiency.

We remain committed to providing the Navy and Marine Corps, in future quarterly reports, with recommendations that improve upon the cost-effectiveness of continued monitoring and groundwater treatment activities. After analytical data from the third consecutive sampling event can be evaluated, and if what I anticipate is the case, I plan to propose a number of additional cost-saving recommendations.
