- Page 7, <u>RAA 2: Institutional Controls</u> Paragraph. In addition to modification of the Base Master Plan institutional controls include recordation of a NOTICE OF INACTIVE HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE OR WASTE DISPOSAL SITE at the Onslow County Courthouse as prescribed in NC General Statute 130A-310.8, an ARAR for this site. Additional institutional controls were discussed in the comments submitted on the Feasibility Study.
- 2. Page 7, <u>RAA 3: Natural Attenuation</u> Paragraph. To be consistent with EPA usage, this alternative should be referred to as Monitored Natural Attenuation.
- 3. Page 8, Last Sentence, First Paragraph. If natural attenuation is undetected (unmonitored?), how will you know it continues?
- 4. Page 9, Compliance with ARARs Paragraph. RAA 3: Natural Attenuation must comply with the action-specific requirements for natural attenuation found in NCAC 2L.0106 (I).
- 5. Page 19, Paragraph <u>RAA2</u>: <u>Institutional Controls with Operational Controls</u>. See Comment 1.
- 6. Page 19, Paragraph RAA3: NA with Operational Controls. See Comment 2.
- 7. Page 21, Paragraph Compliance with ARARs. See Comment 4.
