The Superfund Section received and reviewed these documents and has the following comments:

- 1. Page 2-1, Project Objectives. What are the remediation goals for the contaminated soil excavation? The soil-to-groundwater pathway needs to be considered.
- 2. Page 5-1, Excavation and Confirmatory Sampling. Confirmatory sampling should include volatile, semi-volatile, and metal analyses. The proposed analyses, gasoline range organics, diesel range organics, and oil and grease concentrations, are not necessary for a Superfund cleanup.
