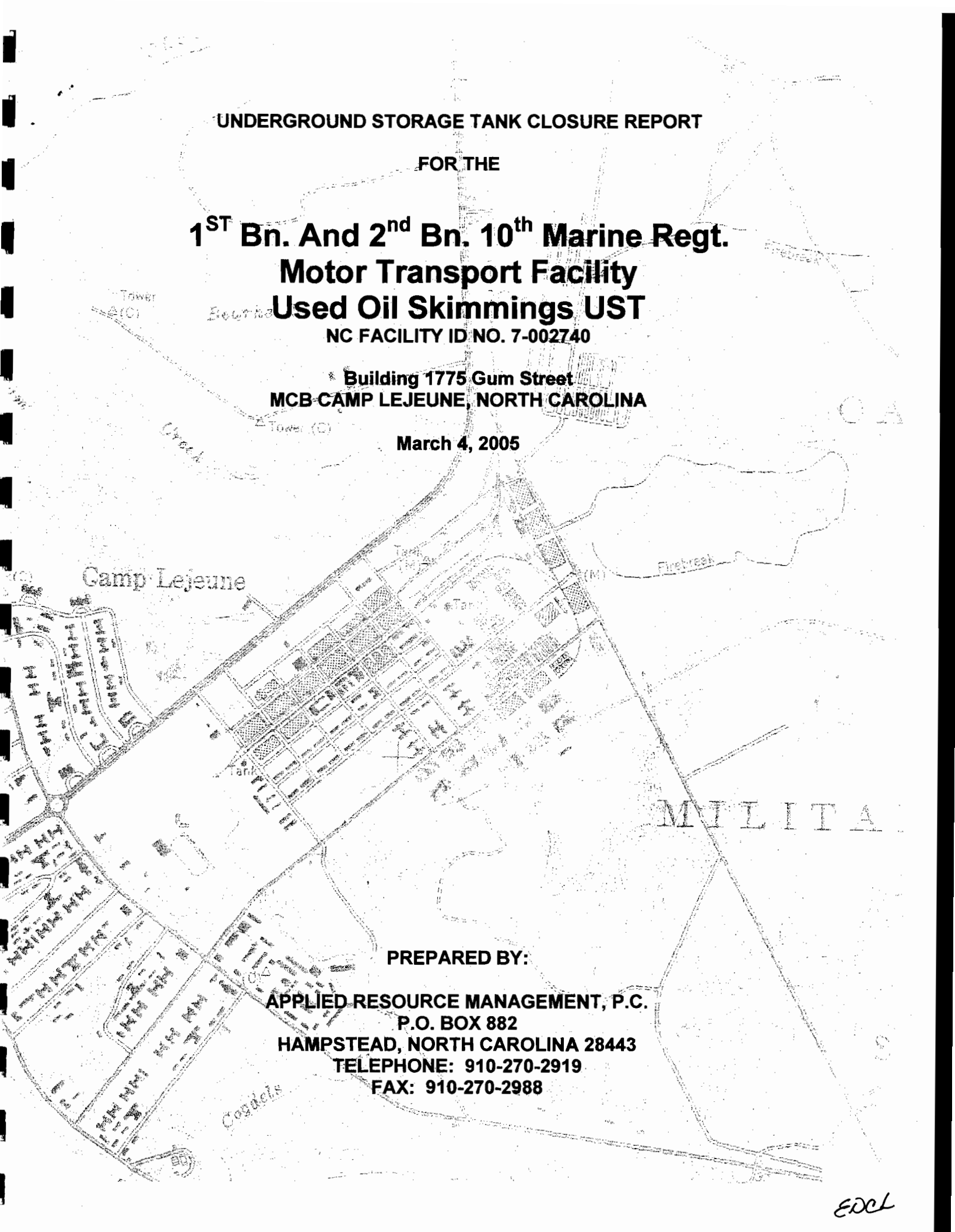

- Backfill the area
