Dear Mr. Humphrey:

The Division of Water Quality (DWQ), formerly the Division of Environmental Management, is currently in receipt of a report submitted for the above referenced site entitled "Initial Site Assessment Report UST Closure by Removal". Since heavy fuel soil contamination remains at the site (300ppm), site closure cannot be granted. However, because all known soil contamination is below the Site Sensitivity Evaluation (SSE) set action level of 1400 parts per million for heavy fuels, no further action is required at this time.
