
Dear Ms. Hall:

On June 17, 1999, the Division completed a review of the subject incident and the site sensitivity evaluation (SSE) received on August 12, 1996. Since the laboratory analytical results for the soil samples associated with the April 1996 reports were below the calculated SSE action level, no further action is required in regard to the subject incident at this time. It shall be a continuing obligation of the United States Marine Corps (USMC) to notify the Department of any changes that might affect the risk assigned to this discharge or release by the Department if the change is known or should be known by the USMC. Further review of this incident also suggests that this site is a "D" site, instead of a "B" site.

The Division's review of the recently received tank closure report for Building 1775-4 indicates that no further action is required by the Division at this time.
