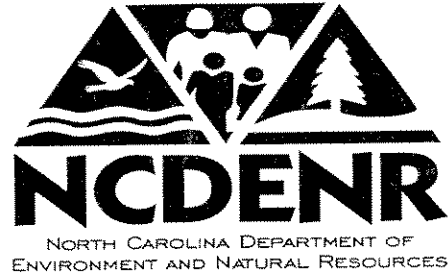

Subject: **Review of Tank Closure Report
 Bldg. 1841-1,2**

Dear Mr. Gwynn:

The Division of Water Quality (DWQ) is in receipt of the tank closure report for the above referenced site. The site has been assigned a priority ranking of 20E (Note: no groundwater samples have been collected at this site). Since the tank closure report indicated that soil contamination of 16,390 parts per million (ppm) Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons (oil and grease) was in close proximity to groundwater, it is likely that groundwater at the site was impacted. For purposes of recordation, in anticipation of rule requirements which will be implemented in 1998, please install at least one monitoring well in the former tank pit area. The well should be screened across the water table and may be temporary. After properly purging and developing the well, please collect a water sample and submit the sample to a North Carolina certified laboratory for the following analyses: EPA methods 502.2 and 625 (with the ten largest peaks identified), and Standard Methods 3030C. Please submit copies of the laboratory reports to this office at the footnote address. If it is determined that groundwater at this site has been adversely impacted by the petroleum release the site may be assigned a higher priority ranking.
