Dear Ms. Hall:

On December 2, 2002, the Division of Waste Management (DWM) Wilmington Regional Office received a Soil Contamination Report for the above-referenced site. A review of the report shows that remaining unsaturated soil in the sidewalls and at the base of the UST system excavation does not contain contaminant levels which exceed either the residential or soil-to-groundwater maximum soil contaminant concentrations established in 15A NCAC 2L .0115(m), whichever are lower. Based on information provided to date, the UST Section classifies the risk posed by the discharge or release as low risk and determines that no further action is required for this incident. This determination shall apply unless the UST Section later determines that the discharge or release poses an unacceptable risk or a potentially unacceptable risk to human health or the environment.

Pursuant to 15A NCAC 2L .0115(e), the USMC has a continuing obligation to notify the DWM of any changes that it knows of or should know of, that might affect the level of risk assigned to the discharge or release. 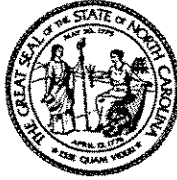

Dear Mr. Warren:

The Division of Water Quality (DWQ), formerly the Division of Environmental Management, has received a request from your office for closure at the above referenced site. Since low levels of high boiling point hydrocarbon soil contamination remains at the site, your request for site closure cannot be granted. However, because all known soil contamination is below the Site Sensitivity Evaluation (SSE) set action level of 480 ppm, no further action is required at this time.
