

Dear Ms. Hall:

Thank you for submitting the subject report to the Division on June 12, 2002. The Division has reviewed the report and offers the following comments:

- Contaminant concentrations detected in groundwater samples are over 2L standards, and a water supply well is located on site about 80 feet away from a former UST. The deep aquifer in this area is under a semi-confined to unconfined condition. The Division cannot issue a No Further Action letter at this time due to language in the letter concerning use of groundwater at contaminated sites. Therefore, it is recommended that the USMC continue to monitor groundwater conditions on at least an annual basis until levels are consistently below 2L standards, or properly abandon the on site well and submit a well abandonment record to the Division.
