

The Division has reviewed the file for the subject incident site. Information contained within the "Closure Analysis" Report shows that contaminated soil was detected around a piping joint for a used motor oil UST. In the report it was stated that five cubic yards of contaminated soil was removed and confirmation sampling showed the TPH concentration did not exceed the regulatory action level. Therefore, no further action is required at this time for the subject incident.
