Dear Ms. Hall:

On September 8, 1997, the Division of Waste Management (DWM) Wilmington Regional Office received a Site Assessment Request for the above-referenced site. A review of this report shows that soil contamination does not exceed the action levels found in the March 1997 Groundwater Section Guidelines for the Investigation and Remediation of Soil and Groundwater. A review of this report and other file documentation also shows that groundwater standards were not contravened, or had been cleaned up to the level of the standards or interim standards established in 15A NCAC 2L .0202.

Based on information provided to date, the DWM determines that no further action is required for this incident. This determination shall apply unless the DWM later determines that the discharge or release poses an unacceptable risk or a potentially unacceptable risk to human health or the environment.


Pursuant to 15A NCAC 2L .0115(e), you have a continuing obligation to notify the DWM of any changes that you know of or should know of, that might affect the level of risk assigned to the discharge or release.
