



- The recommendations within the report are satisfactory. The planned soil excavation should be performed as soon as possible, but in no case later than November 1, 2008. Please notify us 48 hours in advance of the excavation date and time.
- Since SB-05 is a separate source area than the uderground tank area, a monitoring well is required to be constructed at the SB-05 area per 15A NCAC 02L .0405(6)(a). Therefore, this report will not be formally approved until the rule is satisfied. Also, the risk of this incident can not be established until the Division receives this information..
