The Division of Water Quality (DWQ), Aquifer Protection Section is in receipt of the subject report, dated June 2006, and additional correspondence dated July 10, 2006. The report was submitted by Shaw Environmental, Inc. on behalf of the Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Atlantic and received in this office on June 15, 2006. The additional correspondence was received on July 10, 2006. Thank you for these items.

Analytical results, FID readings and soil disposal manifests indicate that all petroleum-contaminated soils at this site have been adequately removed. Groundwater samples were not taken, as groundwater was not encountered during excavation procedures. Based on the information provided, no further action is required. If information is provided in the future that indicates groundwater has been impacted as a result of the incident, then additional assessment and remedial actions might be required.
