Dear Ms. Hall:

The Division has recently completed a review of the subject report and file documentation for the AS-410N site. The report was received on May 9, 2000. Comments concerning the Division's review of the file and report are as follows:

- All possible source areas from the USTs formerly located at this location were not thoroughly investigated. It is also possible that contaminated soil removed during tank excavation was placed back into the tank excavation based upon information contained in the tank closure report.
- Due to the above facts, no further action is not an option at this time. A thorough assessment of vadose zone soil conditions must be performed in the former tank basin and around former tank system components before incident closure can occur. The CSA and tank closure reports remain incomplete until the above referenced assessment is conducted and reported to the Division.
- Please submit well abandonment records for the two supply wells in close proximity to this site as soon as they are abandoned. The Division understands that these wells will be abandoned before January 2001.
