Dear Mr. Warren:

The Division of Water Quality (DWQ), formerly the Division of Environmental Management, is currently in receipt of two reports submitted for the above referenced site entitled, "Three Well Site Check" and "One Well Site Check". According to those reports, low boiling point and high boiling point hydrocarbon soil contamination (620ppm and 270ppm respectively) remains at the site, as well as, low level groundwater contamination in one monitoring well. Since soil and groundwater contamination remain at the site, closure cannot be granted at this time. However, due to the low levels of contamination and the fact that the site has a priority ranking of 35C, no further action is required at this time.
