Dear Mr. Worsley:

The Division of Waste Management (DWM) UST Section has reviewed the subject tank closure report received on May 28, 1993, and the Site Sensitivity Evaluation (SSE) received on October 22, 1993. Soil contamination at the site was reported to be below the calculated Site Sensitivity Evaluation action levels as referenced by the *Groundwater Section Guidelines for the Investigation and Remediation of Soils and Groundwater (March 1993)*. Based on these sampling results and the calculated SSE value, the DWM has determined that no further action is required at this time in conjunction with the subject incident. Worsley Companies, Inc., has a continuing obligation to notify the Division should additional information become available which could affect the status of the site.
