Thank you for submitting the subject letter to this office on December 19, 2005. Review of this letter and the tank closure report indicates that monitoring is satisfactory for this site at this time. Information received by the Base today indicates that no water supply wells are present within 1,000 feet of the subject site. Please sample for the entire volatile suite of compounds recommended in the UST Section Guidelines, just not benzene and VPH, as other volatile organic compounds were detected in the groundwater samples. Please begin this sampling in August 2006, and submit the results and/or a brief report by October 3, 2006.
