Dear Mr. Smith:

On February 13, 2006, the Division of Water Quality (DWQ), Aquifer Protection Section received the subject report. The United States Marine Corps, Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, submitted this report. Thank you for this report.

According to the report, four additional soil samples were taken from the sidewalls of the former soil excavation. The four samples were analyzed for Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons, Diesel Range Organics and Gasoline Range Organics. Laboratory results did not reveal contaminant concentrations in excess of action levels. Based on the information provided, no further action is warranted. If information is provided in the future that indicates groundwater has been impacted as a result of the incident, then additional assessment and remedial actions might be required.

On July 15, 2005, the Division of Water Quality (DWQ), Aquifer Protection Section received the subject report. This report was submitted on behalf of the Department of the Navy, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Atlantic Division, by Shaw Environmental, Inc. Thank you for this report.

According to the report, soil contamination was discovered at the above referenced site during previous investigative work, which was not discussed. The consultant proceeded with excavation of the soil, with three excavation floor samples obtained. A No Further Action designation was recommended by the consultant.

DWQ can not agree with this recommendation, at this time. DWQ personnel reviewed reports obtained from the Division of Waste Management, UST Section, and could not find any information indicating that the horizontal extent of soil contamination has been delineated. If laboratory results exist indicating that the horizontal extent of soil contamination has been defined, please submit to the DWQ, Wilmington Regional Office. Otherwise, delineation soil samples from around the perimeter of the excavation should be obtained, in order to confirm that all soil contamination above action levels has been removed.

For future reference, please consult the Groundwater Section Guidelines for the Investigation and Remediation of Soil and Groundwater, Division of Water Quality, Groundwater Section, July 2000, for all non-UST related petroleum incidents.
