


Dear Ms. Hall:

Thank you for submitting the subject report to this office on June 18, 1998. The Division has reviewed the report and offers the following comments:

1. The Division understands that a replacement well was constructed for well number USTS2633-MW01, and this well was approximately 8 feet away from the original well. The Division must be assured that free-product is removed to less than 1/8 inch thickness. Without a well constructed at the original location, this would be difficult to determine. Therefore, please construct a monitoring well in the former location of well number USTS2633-MW01. Based on the site constraints, hand auger installation of this well is acceptable. Four consecutive quarters of product measurements less than 1/8 inch thickness are required for incident closure. The Division recommends that both of these wells be included in this monitoring, as well as downgradient wells PZ03 and PZ04.
