Dear Ms. Hall:

On May 17, 1999, the Division of Waste Management (DWM) Wilmington Regional Office received a Site Closure Request for the above-referenced site. A review of this report, and the report that was received on June 10, 1996, shows that soil contamination does not exceed the action levels found in the March 1997 Groundwater Section Guidelines for the Investigation and Remediation of Soil and Groundwater. A review of the Site Closure Request also shows that contaminated groundwater has been cleaned up to the level of the standards or interim standards established in 15A NCAC 2L .0202.

Based on information provided to date, the DWM finds it appropriate to lower the risk classification of the discharge or release from high to low. Furthermore, the DWM determines that no further action is required for this incident. This determination shall apply unless the DWM later determines that the discharge or release poses an unacceptable risk or a potentially unacceptable risk to human health or the environment.
