Dear Mr. Reed:

The Soil Cleanup Report and Request for No Further Action Status for the former underground storage tank (UST) site at Building TC-341 is enclosed for your review. This site is located aboard Marine Corps Base, Camp Geiger, North Carolina.

A 1,000-gallon No. 6 heating oil UST system was initially abandoned in place at TC-341. Free product recovery occurred between July 1994 and December 1999. Contaminated soils were excavated over a period from 1997 until January 2000, which included the removal of the UST system in July 1998. Most recent sampling results indicate soil and groundwater contamination is below the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources Action Levels and Gross Contamination Levels, respectively. This site has been classified as "Low Risk."
