Dear Ms. Hall:

The Division has completed its review of the subject incident and the Site Sensitivity Evaluation (SSE) which was included in the R.E. Wright report ("the report") dated June 1995. Laboratory analytical results presented for the soil samples associated with the report were below the calculated SSE action level. The report also indicates that the groundwater has not been impacted by the release of petroleum at this site. Based on this information, no further action is required in regard to the subject incident at this time.

It should be noted that a mistake was found in the calculation used for the SSE value determination included in the report. The Division has determined that the actual SSE value should be 1,650 ppm. In addition, the soil samples collected during tank closure activities were determined to be collected below the water table.
