UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK SITE

Dear Mr. Warren:

The Division of Water Quality (DWQ), is in receipt of the "Initial Site Assessment" report for the above referenced site. Since the report indicated soil contamination of 584 parts per million (ppm) oil and grease (O&G) in contact with groundwater it is likely that groundwater at the site has been impacted. Please complete the following tasks:

- Prepare a site sensitivity evaluation to determine the appropriate clean up level for the impacted soils at this site.
- If soils in excess of the site sensitivity evaluation set clean up level remains at the site, please install at least one monitoring well in the former tank pit area. The well should be screened across the water table. After properly purging and developing the well please collect a water sample and submit the sample to a North Carolina certified laboratory for the following analyses: EPA methods 502.2, 625 (identify the ten largest peaks), and Standard Methods 3030C (metals).
- Please submit information on supply well locations within 1500 feet of the site sufficient to rank this site.

Please submit the requested information to the address at the bottom of the letterhead page as soon as possible.
