When his nine-year-old daughter dies of a rare leukemia, Jerry gives up all else to investigate the cause of her death - leading him to the base's water contamination. Illuminating the personal cost of the contamination, "Semper Fi" recounts how gritty perseverance, honor, and enduring loyalty drive Jerry and fellow Marines to reveal this grave national issue to Congress and the American people.
