

Determining a Nexus

- Review of Scientific/Medical Literature
- Essentially functioning as an expert witness
- Judicial requirements of a medical expert are NOT required in VA medical opinion cases
- Other exposures:
- -OSHA/NIOSH/EPA/ATSDR/ IARC
- References on Commercial Toxicology
- Institute of Medicine Reports where applicable



Determining a Nexus

Reasoning

- Must weigh the probative evidence
- Medical facts in the case for and against a nexus Support in the medical literature or other references for
- Thought process is important

and against a nexus

- Why you put more weight on some evidence than another
- If you disagree with a previously rendered opinion explain why



The Medical Opinion

Conclusion:

- It is more than likely that the claimed condition was caused by the stated event/ exposure/ stressor while on active duty
- It is at least as likely as not (equipoise) that the claimed stressor while on active duty condition was caused by the stated event/ exposure/

- "Cannot opine without resorting to speculation"
