I am sure you have already heard, but the Secretary called Burr, Tillis, and Isakson this morning to announce his decision to create a presumption of service connection for 8 diseases. Letters have been sent to the HVAC and SVAC and news agencies will be notified at 2:00. Until final regs are published, however, that will not reduce your workload. Sorry about that. We will continue to process claims as we do now and grant those that we can, but will defer a denial for one of the 8 presumptives until the regs are published. The presumptives are: Kidney cancer; Liver Cancer; non-Hodgkin Lymphoma; Leukemias; Multiple Myeloma; Scleroderma; Parkinson's disease; and Aplastic Anemia/Myelodysplastic Syndromes.

This is the highest priority reg for the Secretary so we will do all we can to get a final rule published. As a notice and comment rulemaking, it generally takes about 2 years. We will try to get it done in less than 18 months, but that won't be easy.


Good afternoon,

The request for opinion for (b) (6) asked for opinions on lung cancer and skin cancer, but these were not the primary issue that required an opinion. The Veteran's March 17, 2015 Statement in Support of Claim states "On 1987 I was diagnosed with Chronic Myelogenous Leukemia; symptoms began in 1986. In 1987, I received a bone marrow transplant. In 2001, I was diagnosed with lung cancer. I am not a smoker. Research shows that patients that have received bone marrow transplants have a higher probability of developing another cancer in the future. I underwent a lobectomy followed by local radiation and chemotherapy. For approximately 20-25 years, I have been treated for basal cell carcinomas, primarily on my face, chest and back. My physicians attribute the high frequency to total body radiation, received as part of the bone marrow transplant."

T Thus his primary claim is actually for the CML, with the lung and skin cancers being secondary to the treatments for the leukemia. In fact, when I looked at his Application for Disability Compensation and Related Compensation Benefits claim (21-526EZ) signed on 3/11/2015, the first condition listed in Section 9 is "Leukemia-Camp Lejeune". Since there was not already an SME opinion regarding the primary condition, this is the one I focused on.

At the end of the twelfth paragraph of my report, dated December 3, 2015, I stated "I agree with (b) (6) statement in support of claim that it is at least as likely as not that these two malignancies are secondary to his leukemia treatment." Thus, whereas I agree that the lung and skin cancers are secondary to the leukemia, I consider it less likely as not that the leukemia is secondary to exposure to CLCW. Having said that, once the current proposed conditions are granted presumption status, the leukemia and therefore the secondary conditions of lung and skin cancer will be service connected.







So, all in all, a good start. I hope you are doing well.





Sorry I have not gotten back to you sooner on this. I have been talking with DMA and with (b) (6) about claims for kidney conditions, many of which are unspecified as to what the condition actually is. I believe that part of the problem is that in the 2009 National Research Council report on Camp Lejeune, one of the disabilities listed as having limited or suggestive evidence of an association with the contaminants in the water at Lejeune is "renal toxicity." This is so unclear that VHA went back to the Institute of Medicine asking what was meant by that? Their report was delivered to VA earlier this year and VHA is finalizing its response to the report.

Basically, "renal toxicity" refers to chronic kidney disease including end-stage renal disease, chronic renal insuffiency, and chronic renal failure. If a Veteran provides evidence that he or she has one of these conditions or has evidence of having kidney cancer, and medical evidence of record is not sufficient to fairly decide the claim, then a medical opinion needs to be requested.

A claim for "kidney condition" is not sufficient. There must be medical evidence of a diagnosis of a "kidney condition" and as part of VA's duty to assist, we need to ask the claimant for medical evidence of a current disability and medical or scientific evidence showing a relationship between the claimed disability and exposure to the contaminated water at Camp Lejeune. If the claimant provides that evidence and there is not sufficient evidence to fairly decide the claim, then a medical opinion should be requested. If the claimant does not provide the requested evidence in a timely manner, then the appropriate action can be taken.

This process is one that should be followed, basically, in all claims for compensation unless there is a statutory or regulatory presumption for a particular disease associated with a particular occupational or environmental exposure. We will follow this email up with written guidance.


