Dear Mr. Froede:

We have received the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region IV comments (letter dated November 19, 1991) to the MCB Camp Lejeune FY-1992 Draft Final Site Management Plan (SMP). The EPA's only comment concerned Community Relations with regard to the "PRAP." We agree to reference the appropriate Community Relations milestones (public comment period, public meeting) next to the "PRAP" milestone in the "Final" version of the SMP.

In the FY-1991 and FY-1992 SMP, we presented an expedited schedule for the Operable Unit No. 1 (Hadnot Point) "Shallow Aquifer." This is the only expedited schedule in the SMP. The remaining SMP schedules reflect FFA-prescribed timeframes. You have more recently requested we expedite additional site schedules. Since expedited schedules are not enforceable and not a part of the FFA, these are submitted separate from the SMP.


We propose that the Final FY-1992 SMP reflect an FFA-prescribed schedule for Operable Unit No. 1 Shallow Aquifer versus the expedited schedule currently in the Draft Final. This expedited schedule is currently reflected in the Draft Expedited Site Schedule submitted to EPA and the State on December 12, 1991.

We intend to revise the Draft Final SMP to incorporate the above changes and submit the "Final" FY-92 SMP within 45 days receipt of this letter. To support this schedule, please notify us within 10 days receipt of this letter if EPA does not concur with the change (Hadnot Point Shallow Soils) discussed above.
