SUBJ: CLOSURE OF CONTAMINATED WATER WELLS

1. Fifteen water wells are currently out of service due to contamination. These wells have various levels of contamination, and some of the wells may be recoverable. Guidance is needed on what to do with the wells. A new well costs approximately \$120,000 and replacement cost for the secured wells is over \$1,800,000. If the wells can not be reclaimed, removal of equipment, demolition of well houses, and capping of wells need to be pursued.


