The North Carolina Superfund Section has received and reviewed the Draft Final Site Management Plan for the subject site. As discussed in our letters of 18 March 1991 and 16 April 1991, and during our meetings with EPA and Navy representatives on 18 March 1991 and 16 April 1991, a groundwater contamination potential exist at Site 3, Old Creosote Plant and Site 80, Paradise Point (Golf Course Pesticide Area). Installation and sampling of groundwater monitoring wells should therefore be included in the Scope of Work for the Old Creosote Plant on page 6-14 and the Paradise Point (Golf Course Pesticide Area) on page 6-25 of the subject document.
